

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Nanotechnology Prototype Showcase -October 15, Stevens Institute of Technology Hoboken, NJ

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Thursday, September 25 at 6 PM

SCOPE

New Jersey Technology Council, is seeking abstracts and presentations from companies and universities developing early stage products enabled by nanotechnology. These abstracts and accompanying presentations will be the focus of the Council's 12th Nano conference, which will focus on Nanotechnology Prototypes.

Abstracts accepted will be presented at a conference scheduled for the afternoon of October 15th at Stevens Institute of Technology. Abstracts will be accepted either for 15 minute presentations during the conference or poster presentations which will be at a networking reception immediately following the conference presentations.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

Accepted abstracts will be housed on the Council's website for six months and will be made available to members and the technology community. Authors are not required to transfer copyright. Accepted abstracts that are selected for oral presentation may be accompanied by a Power Point presentation no longer than 15 minutes in length. The Power Point presentation will also be housed on the Council's website. We encourage authors to submit an abstract no longer than 300 words in length. Over-length submissions may be rejected without review or notice to the author. Presentation should be submitted in either Word, PDF and HTML formats. Authors should submit a short title at the beginning of their submission that summarizes the content of their abstract. All entries will be reviewed by a selection committee composed of local university and corporate representatives.
