

Reaction paper

- 1/3 page summarizing the studies in the article.
 - Research questions asked
 - How they studied and the main findings
 - Their conclusions
- The rest for your reaction. Expand on your ideas.
 - How does the research relate to life in general? Your own experiences?
 - Sound research? Or problematic? Interesting? Confusing?
- While reading
 - Pay attention to how they structure the paper – introduction with previous research, methods, results, and discussion
 - To fully understand the results, you need to know IV and DV if available (method section)
 - Think about threats to internal (confound) and external validity (low generalizability) .
- In your last paper, you are going to propose a study (or you can actually conduct a study with your friends) and your write up should look like the articles you are reading.
